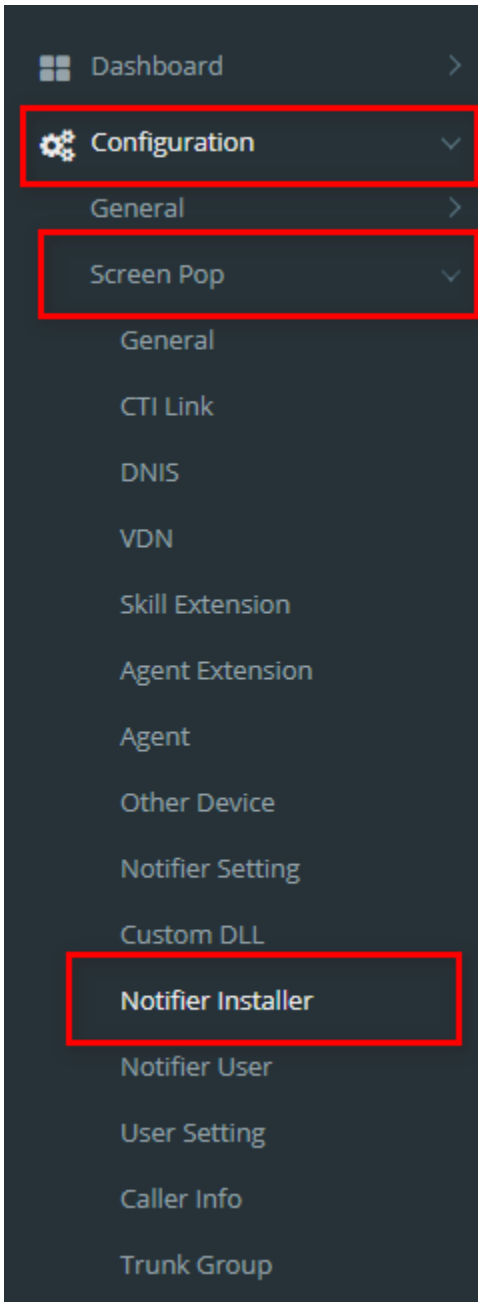


How to manage Notifier Installer at Screen Pop Configuration

Step-by-step guide

- Go to Linkscope Web application and if you're not already signed in, select **Sign in**.
- From the Linkscope Web application, you click to **Configuration ? Screen Pop? Notifier Installer** at the menu.

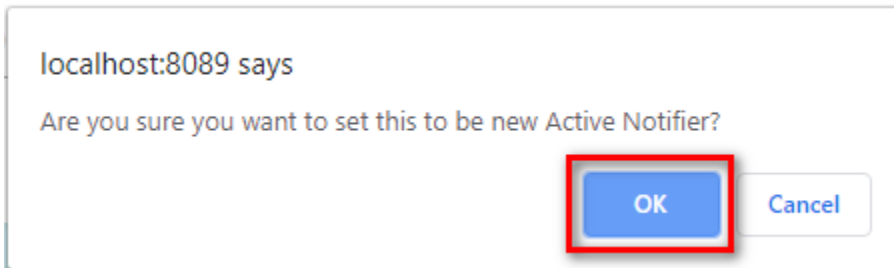



INACTIVE/REACTIVE A NOTIFIER INSTALLER

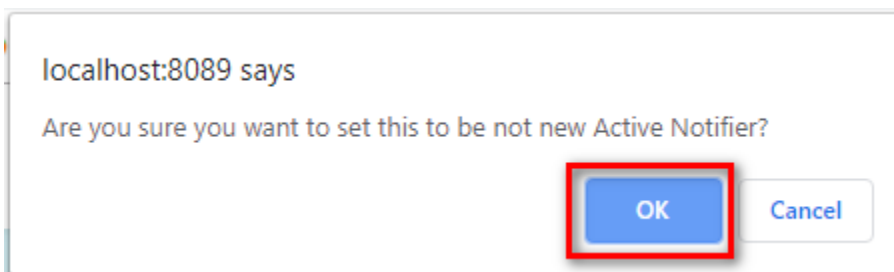
1. On **Notifier Installer** table, select any row you want to Inactive/Reactive.








- If you want to **Reactive** that user, click  button. There're alert displays after you click to this button. Select **OK**.

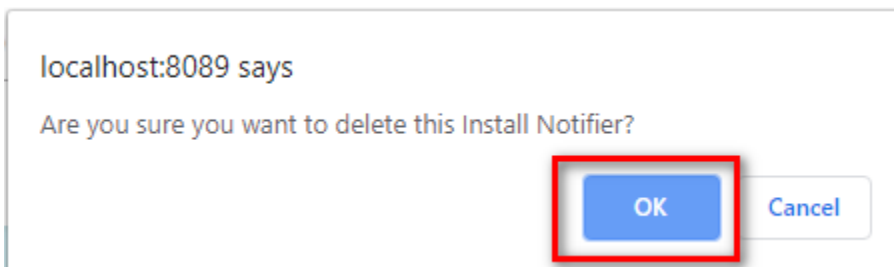


DELETE A NOTIFIER INSTALLER

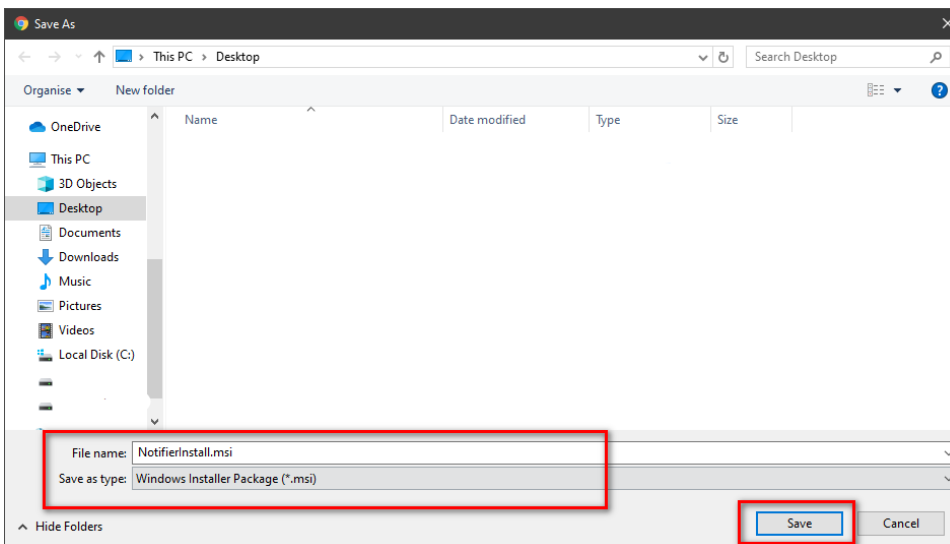
DOWNLOAD A NOTIFIER FILE
